✓ **Free/Libre/Open Source Software**

Collaboration

Source Code

Open Standards

FUD



Open Source Software



- ✓ **Free Redistribution**
- ✓ **Source Code**
 - ✓ Must be available
 - ✓ Integrity: Modifications released as patches.
- ✓ **Derived Works**
 - ✓ Allowed
 - ✓ Distributed in the same terms
- ✓ **License**
 - ✓ Technology neutral
 - ✓ No restriction of other software
 - ✓ No discrimination



Free Software



- ✓ **Coined by GNU Project**
- ✓ **Based on freedom**
 - ✓ **Freedom 0: The freedom to run the program, for any purpose**
 - ✓ **Freedom 1: The freedom to study how the program works, and adapt it to your needs**
 - ✓ **Freedom 2: The freedom to redistribute copies so you can help your neighbor**
 - ✓ **Freedom 3: The freedom to improve the program, and release your improvements to the public, so that the whole community benefits.**
- ✓ **Free software is open-source software, but not all open-source software is free.**

✓ **Some Stats**

- ✓ **Apache is the #1 web server [69.70%]**
- ✓ **GNU/Linux is the #2 web serving OS on the public Internet (counting by physical machine) [30%]**
- ✓ **95% of all reverse-lookup domain name servers (DNS) used bind**

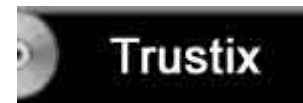
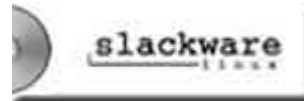
Linux



- ✓ Late 1980s -Linus Torvalds, a young Finnish graduate student decides to write his own kernel (OS) because he cannot afford the license fee for a commercial OS.
- ✓ 1991 - Linus posts the kernel source code to Usenet news group "comp.os.minix." He calls his OS "Linux." He releases it under the GPL!
- ✓ His work is criticized by a few but overall response is very encouraging.
- ✓ Many programmers across the globe join his effort to write a completely "unencumbered" Unix-like OS.

- ☑ **Mail Servers : Sendmail, PostFix , QMail**
- ☑ **Mailing Lists : Mailman , Majordomo**
- ☑ **DNS Server : BIND**
- ☑ **Proxy Servers : Squid**
- ☑ **Interoperability : Samba**
- ☑ **Open source "back office" services such as databases (Mysql, PostgreSQL), portal (PHP-Nuke).**
