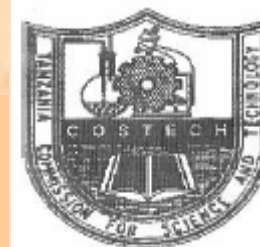

Introduction

- FOSS is providing ICT Communities worldwide with a valuable tool to address certain aspects of the so called digital divide and social economic development in general
- There is an increasing momentum in Africa and Tanzania in specific for migrating to FOSS & in fact several initiatives/projects are in place
- However to have a significant impact to the country social economic development a broad based association needs to be established, as a platform for coordinating and developing initiatives aimed at nurturing the hitherto spontaneous emergence of FOSS in and around Tanzania Community.
- The TAFOSSA is such broad based association and is a proposed non-profit organization to advocate and promote FOSS for rapidly developing access to, and utilization of, Information and Communication Technologies(ICT) in Tanzania

Introduction...

- The idea was born during the OSS Seminar at UCC 4th February, 2004
- First brainstorming session to further the idea was done at COSTECH 10th march, 2004 where the Interim Secretariat were put in place
- This was followed by the full day workshop on 31st march, 2004 at Protea Apartments that defined the direction of TAFOSSA
- Several meetings/works followed and now we have draft constitution and Draft Roadmap in place and have been brought for discussion/validation in this workshop
- Parallel to this several activities have been done under umbrella of TAFOSSA
