

# The Tanzania Commission for Universities (TCU)

(formerly the Higher Education Accreditation Council (HEAC))

## LOGO DESIGN COMPETITION

The Tanzania Commission for Universities (TCU) was established by the Universities Act No. 7 of 2005 which came into force on 1<sup>st</sup> July, 2005. The TCU shall carry out and continue the functions of the former Council, the Higher Education Accreditation Council, (HEAC).

As part of this transformation of the HEAC into the TCU, the Commission is in dire need for a new logo to replace that of the HEAC. The Commission therefore invites individuals and companies to propose the design of the TCU's logo.

The logo should include the Commission's name, and a motto that uniquely reflects the Commission's mission which is "to become a world class Commission that ensures a well coordinated and regulated university level higher education and quality inputs, processes and outputs and awards from universities for enhanced sustainable economic growth and development of Tanzania"

### AWARD

A prize of Tshs 500,000/= will be awarded to the winning entry. The first and second runners-up will receive motivational prizes of Tshs. 300,000/= and Tshs. 200,000/= respectively. All entries must be original and in art work.

### PROPERTY RIGHTS

The winner shall vest all rights in respect of the proposed logo to the TCU. Therefore, all entries should include a declaration that the property rights in respect of the work will be transferred to the Tanzania Commission for Universities, and that no part thereof shall be used for any purpose by anybody or body of persons without the express approval of the Commission.

### SUBMISSION OF ENTRIES

Entries in soft and/or hard copies should be submitted latest by 1400 hours on Friday 3rd February, 2006. Hard copies should be submitted in triplicate.
